Dear Sir,

I, Santosh Kumar Tibrewalla, Practising Company Secretary has been appointed by the Board of Directors of M/s. Indo-Eco (India) Ltd. (the Company) as a scrutinizer as per the provisions of Section 108 /109 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 & 21 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, for the purpose of scrutinizing the process of remote e-voting & voting carried out by means of Ballot papers at the venue of the Annual General Meeting of the Company and ascertaining the requisite majority on voting carried out on the resolutions contained in the notice to the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the members of the Company, held on the 20th day of September, 2016 at '3B, Alipore Avenue, Kolkata - 700 027'.

1. The Management of the Company is responsible to ensure the Compliance with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013, Rules made thereunder and SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 relating to voting through electronic means & ballot paper on the resolutions contained in the Notice to the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the members of the Company. My responsibility as a scrutinizer for the voting process is restricted to make a Scrutinizer's report of the votes cast in "favour" or "against" the resolutions stated above, based on the reports generated from the e-voting system provided by the National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL), the authorised agency to provide e-voting facilities, engaged by the Company and voting conducted by means of Ballot Papers at the venue of the Annual General Meeting.
2. Further to the above, I submit my report as under:-
 - i) The remote e-voting period remained open from Saturday, 17th September, 2016 (9.00 A.M.) to Monday, 19th September, 2016 (5.00 P.M.).
 - ii) The members of the Company as on the "cut-off" date i.e. 13th September, 2016 were entitled to vote on the resolutions (items no. 1 to 4 as set out in the notice of the AGM of the Company).
 - iii) The facility of Ballot voting was provided at the venue of the AGM only to those members present who had not casted their votes by remote e-voting.



- iv) The ballot box kept for voting by means of ballot paper was locked in my presence.
- v) On conclusion of the Voting at the venue of the AGM held on 20th September, 2016, the votes casted through Ballot Papers were duly scrutinized by opening the ballot box in my presence. The ballot papers were reconciled with the records maintained by the Registrar and Transfer Agents of the Company and the authorisations / proxies lodged with the Company.
- vi) I did not find any ballot papers invalid.
- vii) Thereafter, votes casted through remote e-voting were unblocked on 20th September, 2016 in the presence of 2 witnesses, Ms. Pooja Patel and Ms. Richa Shaw, who are not in the employment of the Company. They have signed below in confirmation of the votes being unblocked in their presence.
